We specialize in healing chronic wounds

If you are suffering from a non-healing wound, you are not alone. Every year, chronic wounds caused by diabetes, poor circulation, extended periods of immobility and other conditions keep 3 to 5 million Americans just like you from doing the things they love to do.

Our multidisciplinary team of healthcare professionals is dedicated to treating wounds, including those that have resisted healing after months or even years of traditional treatment. Our goal is to improve your health and help you return to the activities you enjoy.

Your healing program

After you and your doctor have determined that you can be helped by the Wound Care Clinic, we will set up your first appointment. During this visit, our staff will evaluate your wound and general health. Testing may be required to give us information about blood and oxygen flow in the wound area.

After any test results are complete, we will put together a treatment program designed especially for you and your unique needs. The program will include regular visits to the Wound Care Clinic to provide treatment, evaluate

progress, and make adjustments as your healing progresses. At each visit, you and/or your caregiver will be given detailed instructions for home care, dressing changes, and protecting the wound from further injury.

You are a vital part of the healing program. Much of the success of your treatment depends on keeping appointments, following directions carefully, and monitoring progress closely between visits.

We work closely with your doctor

The Bluffton Regional Wound Care Clinic staff works with your doctor to discuss your treatment program and keep him or her updated on your progress. Since our focus is wound care, you will continue to see your doctor for other medical care.

Types of wounds treated

- Diabetic ulcers
- Crush injuries
- Pressure sores
- Circulatory wounds
- Infections of the extremities
- Gangrene
- Non-healing surgical wounds
- Trauma wounds

Insurance coverage

Most health insurance plans cover Wound Care Clinic treatment. Your coverage depends on your specific plan. Be sure to bring your insurance card(s) with you when you visit the Wound Care Clinic.
